



BETTI FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

OUR MISSION: The Bruno and Evelyne Betti Foundation was created through the Bruno and Evelyne Betti estates to continue the philanthropic mission they followed during their lifetime. In 2020 the Betti Foundation donated to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Thurston County to benefit three areas of the organization, general operating costs, scholarships for children to attend the Clubs, and scholarships for graduating Club Members. This scholarship will be awarded yearly to current and former Club Members who meet the qualifications.

SCHOLARSHIP	 Can be up to a 4-year renewable scholarship, must re-apply annually. The range of scholarships is based on the amount of money available and the number of applicants (\$1000-\$10,000) Amount will be based on the school or program the student is attending.
QUALIFICATIONS	 Club member for 2 years or more unless Branch Director or Admin Letter of Recommendation. Student must have attended school in Thurston County within the last two years. Report to the Board on your progress yearly. Must have attended and graduated from a high school in Thurston County. Exceptions can be made by the scholarship committee, to include applicants that don't meet these specific qualifications.
